

**VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE  
PARKING REGULATION NUMBER 7**

**SECTION 1**

**ENABLING LEGISLATION AND TITLE**

This regulation is adopted pursuant to Section 3 of Village of Cambridge Local Law Number 3 for 1987 and Section 1640(a)(6) of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, and shall be known as “Parking Regulation Number 7” of the Village of Cambridge. This regulation may be cited as VOC 87-3, R6.

**SECTION 2**

**REGULATION**

2.1 Parking on Cambridge Woods Lane in the Village of Cambridge shall be subject to parking restrictions set forth at all times, with parking prohibited on the Northerly side of Cambridge Woods Lane from Avenue B thence in a Westerly direction to the end of Cambridge Woods Lane. Said restrictions shall apply as follows:

No person shall park, stop or leave standing any vehicle on the Northerly side of Cambridge Woods Lane within from Avenue B thence in a Westerly direction to the end of Cambridge Woods Lane.

**SECTION 3**

**POSTING OF REGULATION**

The superintendent of Public Works of the Village of Cambridge is hereby directed to obtain official signs conforming to the Uniform Traffic Control Manual and

the Regulations of the New York State Department of Transportation, and to post said signs at such places upon or along Cambridge Woods Lane as may be necessary to advise motorists of this Regulation.

#### **SECTION 4**

##### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Regulation shall take effect on the date that signs have been posted in accordance with Section 3 of this Regulation.
