

VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE
PARKING REGULATION NUMBER 4

SECTION 1

ENABLING LEGISLATION AND TITLE

This regulation is adopted pursuant to Section 3 of Village of Cambridge Local Law Number 3 for 1987 and Section 1640(a)(6) of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, and shall be known as "Parking Regulation Number 4" of the Village of Cambridge. This regulation may be cited as VOC 87-3, R4.

SECTION 2

REGULATION

2.1 Parking on the south side of First Street in the Village of Cambridge shall be regulated as follows:

(a) A Handicapped Parking Zone shall be established on the south side of the street, beginning at a point 35' east of NIMO Power Pole #4 and running thence east a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.

2.2 Parking on the south side of West Main Street in the Village of Cambridge shall be regulated as follows:

(a) A Handicapped Parking Zone shall be established on the south side of the street, beginning at a point 140' east of NIMO Power Pole #18/1 and running thence east a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.

(b) A Handicapped Parking Zone shall be established on the south side of the street, beginning at a point 165' east of NIMO Power Pole 18/1, and running thence east a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.

SECTION 3

POSTING OF REGULATION


The Superintendent of Public Works of the Village of Cambridge is hereby directed to obtain official signs conforming to the Uniform Traffic Control Device Manual and the Regulations of the New York State Department of Transportation, and to post said signs at such places upon or along East Main Street as may be necessary to advise motorists of this Regulation.

SECTION 4

EFFECTIVE DATE


This Regulation shall take effect on the date that signs have been posted in accordance with Section 3 of this Regulation.
